## DOG OWNERSHIP = RESPONSIBILITY

Owning a dog takes a commitment of time, effort, education and money. Dogs, like children, need love, attention, training, food, medical care, and some miscellaneous items during their lifetime. Before you commit yourself to the responsibility of a pet, please take into consideration the long term costs.
